As Chairman of the Building Committee, I would like to let everyone know how we are progressing even if much slower than we would like. The deed for the land has been signed turned over to the Fire Department after delays involving Bryan's "Extra territorial jurisdiction". The specifications have been written, put out for bid and a general contractor selected. Bryan Utilities has moved some power lines for the Department. Therefore, with some luck the financing will be in place and papers signed, within the week. Then some of the site work can get started. One of the

problems we are having is all the bids were over budget. We were able to increase the amount of the construction loan, but that means we will have a bigger payment for a longer period of time. We are hoping some of our Fund Raising efforts will be successful.

R.M. Dudley Construction was the successful bidder and is working very hard with us to trim costs. If there are any building suppliers or sub contractors who would like to donate, please contact James Drews of R.M. Dudley or myself. Please note that all "in kind" donations have to meet the building specifications and be coordinated through the General Contractor. Cash donations sent to the Department may be earmarked for the "Building Fund".
