Reflective 9-1-1 Address Signs

The Brazos County Precinct 3 Volunteer Fire Department provides reflective address signs to assist emergency responders in locating your residence or business. Signs are \$15.00 each, and are available in a vertical or horizontal orientation. They include numbers on both sides of the sign.

The signs come with pre-drilled holes in all four corners (covered by the green reflective coating) to assist in mounting to a mailbox or fence. If being located independently, we can provide a 3-foot tall metal post/stake to attach the sign to, if requested.

For residents residing within the primary response district of Precinct 3 VFD (generally, south of State Highway 21, and east of the College Station city limits in the area of William D. Fitch Pkwy), our members can deliver and/or install the sign(s) for you. A member of our department will call to make arrangements for delivery and/or installation.



For locations outside of our response district, we, unfortunately, don't have personnel with the availability to personally deliver & install the signs. However, we support the use of the reflective address signs regardless of location. Therefore, Brazos County 9-1-1 District has graciously agreed to hold and distribute signs for locations outside of our response area. They can be picked up 8am – 5pm, Monday through Friday, at the Brazos County 9-1-1 District office located at 101 Regent Ave, Bryan, TX, 77803. A representative from our department will call to let you know when your sign is ready for pick up at the 9-1-1 District Office.
